Poema Cava , Sparking Rose, Spain <i>Aromas and flavors typical of Trepas, with fresh and elegant notes of strawberry, raspberry and rose petals.</i>	\$10 \$38
Bola , Prosecco, Italy <i>This extra dry Prosecco is fresh and fruity, with lovely aromas of pear, apple and peach.</i>	\$11 \$42
Mumm Brut Prestige , Napa, California <i>White blossom aromas, creamy vanilla with rounded oak, soft texture, citrus, rich, honey-baked brioche.</i>	\$58
Domaine Carneros Brut , Napa, California <i>Lovely aromas of pear, golden apple, honeycomb, lemon zest and brioche lead to a very round palate and long silky finish.</i>	\$79
GH Mumm Brut , Champagne, France <i>Rich and complex, with aromas of citrus fruit, dried orange peel, coffee, nuts and spices are undercut by a distinctive flinty minerality.</i>	\$98

ROSÉ

Erath , Willamette Valley, Oregon <i>A pleasant nose of rose and watermelon, same flavors on the palate with the addition of raspberry, with nice balance and acidity.</i>	\$38
Diora , Monterey, California <i>Pinot Noir Rosé harvested earlier in the season when good natural acidity remains in the grapes. Flavors of juicy wild strawberries and raspberries, crisp and well balanced.</i>	\$11 \$42
Ava Grace , Central Valley, California <i>Delicate and soft bursting with aromas of red berries and stone fruit. The palate is filled with raspberry, citrus and apricot that leads into a balanced, dry finish.</i>	\$9 \$34
Vanderpump , Provence, France <i>Elegant nose with delicate red currant and hints of pepper as well as sweet citrus. On the palate, it reveals a touch of strawberry, tangerine, and peach in a dry, classic style.</i>	\$47

Caposaldo , Moscato, Lombardy, Italy <i>Intense pear, peach and spice aromas enhanced with fresh bubbles.</i>	\$10 \$38
Conundrum , White Blend, California <i>Hints of honeysuckle, wildflowers, and lemon blossoms, layered with starfruit, honeydew and a hint of minerality. Crisp with a vibrant acidity.</i>	\$12 \$46
Trimbach , Riesling, Alsace, France <i>Delicate bouquet, the fine balance between its dryness, its fruitiness and its natural minerality contribute to its rich finish.</i>	\$48
Pacific Rim , Riesling, Columbia Valley, Washington <i>It displays aromas of jasmine and citrus. The subtly sweet profile is balanced by bright and refreshing acidity.</i>	\$28
Sella & Mosca La Calla , Vermentino di Sardegna, Italy <i>Dry, pear nose, minerals, citrus-lime, light on aromas of grass and vegetal tones. Nice subtlety on the palate and no overt acid.</i>	\$32
Terra d' Oro , Chenin Blanc- Viognier, Clarksburg, California <i>Aromas of juicy tropical fruits, fresh lemon and hints of spice. The palate has flavors of pink grapefruit, papaya, and subtle sweet mango.</i>	\$34

PINOT GRIGIO / PINOT GRIS

Rocca Delle Macie , Lombardy, Italy <i>Bright flavors of lemon, green apple and pear, mouthwatering finish.</i>	\$12 \$46
Willakenzie Estate , Pinot Gris, Willamette Valley, Oregon <i>Rich and full fruit expressions of pear and papaya with a strong backbone of acidity, long finish.</i>	\$48
Jermann , Pinot Grigio, Friuli-Venezia Alto Giulia, Italy <i>Notes of green apple, juicy Bartlett pear and fresh-cut citrus fill the palate, with a crisp mineral edge and hints of honey and melon on the long finish.</i>	\$55
Banfi San Angelo , Pinot Grigio, Toscana, Italy <i>A light to medium bodied wine with a fruity and floral bouquet on the nose. Pear, honey and mineral notes from start to finish on the palate.</i>	\$38

SAUVIGNON BLANC / SANCERRE

Emmolo , Napa, California <i>Scents of melon and lavender notes of wet stone. Light on the palate with ripeness, from peaches to bright citrus. The finish trails off with a balance of fruit and acidity.</i>	\$12 \$46
Liquid Light , Chateau St. Michelle, Washington <i>A light bodied wine that is fresh and crisp with citrus fruit notes of grapefruit, lime and green apple. Notes of summer grass to add to the sweet tart finish.</i>	\$38
Villa Maria , Marlborough, New Zealand <i>Classic Marlborough flavors dominated by gooseberry, passion fruit, fresh citrus, melon and herbaceous aromas. Enticing palate with a juicy flavor profile, purity and concentration, finishing crisp and clean with an interwoven thread of acidity.</i>	\$42
Jean Vincent Sancerre , Loire, France <i>Tense, mineral and concentrated. The white-fruit, gooseberry and spice flavors have a juicy character, refreshing, crisp and with an acidic finish.</i>	\$58

CHARDONNAY

Blackwall's "Rustic Reserve" , Rutherford, California <i>Bright gold in color with aromas of fresh citrus peel an apple, with vanilla and cinnamon.</i>	\$10 \$38
Michael David , Lodi, California <i>Pure Chardonnay fruit with complements from French oak aging and partial malolactic fermentation. The wine is ripe with aromas of crisp green apple, light citrus, and spiced peach.</i>	\$13 \$50
Lincourt Steel , Santa Rita Hills, California <i>Aromatics of fresh lemon lime flower with hints of fresh guava juice. On the palate, it has a bright citrus pop with accents of nectarine and fresh yellow peach that linger on the finish. This is the perfect spring time brunch.</i>	\$42
Buehler Vineyards , Russian River Valley, California <i>This wine displays abundant floral/ stone fruit aromas lightly accented by toasty, graham cracker sur-lie qualities. The mouth feel is creamy and full but the natural acidity of the Russian River fruit carries this velvet textured package to a long, clean finish.</i>	\$48
Clos Pegase Mitsuko's Vineyard , Carneros, California <i>Clear lemon yellow in the glass. Upfront aromas of peach, melon, cut straw and bakers spice. A smooth delivery on the palate displays flavors of stone fruit, cantaloupe and pears with subtle notes of brioche and toasted coconut. The acid is bright and maintains a pleasant balance in the wine.</i>	\$52
Stag's Leap Wine Cellars "Karia" , Chardonnay, Napa, California <i>Aromas of pear, white peach, and honeysuckle, medium bodied, hints of minerality and lemon zest on the finish.</i>	\$79

PINOT NOIR

10 Span , Central Coast, California <i>Aromas of cherries with a touch of red currants and a hint of spice.</i>	\$10 \$38
Acrobat , Oregon <i>Fruit-forward aromas like ripe cherries and strawberry pie, hints of cinnamon, vanilla and mocha. Palate with ripe strawberries and dark chocolate up front, followed by earthy and spicy notes of forest floor and clove.</i>	\$13 \$50
"Inscription" , King Estate, Willamette Valley, Oregon <i>This wine delivers with fresh red fruit flavors, like raspberry and ripe strawberry. There are definitive Oregon flavors of mushroom, forest floor and earth. This is rich and well-built with oak and vanilla nuances attributed to aging in French oak.</i>	\$45
Willakenzie Estate "Gisele" , Willamette Valley, Oregon <i>This Pinot Noir displays tremendous fruit intensity. Ccool nights aided in the retention of the natural acidity and freshness the region is known for. Offering ample freshness, juicy red fruit and spice on the nose, carrying through to an approachable palate with wonderful fruit concentration and length.</i>	\$58
"Eternally Silenced" , St. Helena, California <i>Rich and elegant, soft and well-balanced. Aromas of pine needles, cranberry, dark cherry, cedar, clove, and brown spice lead to fresh red berry flavors, ample structure, and seamless tannins.</i>	\$95
Penner-Ash , Willamette Valley, Oregon <i>Strawberry, anise and tea spice aromatics. Ripe, fresh raspberry, red plums and strawberry compote with a hint of subtle cedar. The fine texture and silky tannins enhance the vanilla, brown sugar, and leather notes on the finish.</i>	\$92

MALBEC

Trapiche , Broquel, Mendoza, Argentina <i>Fresh red and black fruits, floral notes, earthy minerals, rich and spicy with a long and pleasant finish.</i>	\$12 \$46
Salentein Reserve , Tunuyán, Argentina <i>Very intense purplish red color. In the nose, it is intense and complex with outstanding aromas of red fruits, blackberries, as well as delicate floral notes. Its fruity flavor is mild yet sweet with good intensity with a lingering finish.</i>	\$48

Napa Cellars, Napa, California

Aromas of toasty baking spices, vanilla, malt and fresh ripe plums. Alongside alluring flavors of juicy blueberry, blackberry, cherry and a hint of dark chocolate and toffee.

“Saldo”, Zinfandel, St. Helena, California

Dark ruby color with bold aromas of black licorice, black pepper, cherry, and baking spice.

Rich, full, and scintillating. The palate with a hint of chocolate. The finish is voluptuous with soft, velvety tannins.

Mc Guigan “The Plan”, Shiraz, South East Australia

A combination of plum and blackberry aromas with spice, pepper and cinnamon. Well-rounded and fruity with rich flavors of ripe plum, blackberry jam and spices balanced with vanilla and caramel flavors.

The purity of fruit is elevated by its silky texture and hints of kirsch and cassis, olive, and fennel.
